The database

In addition, there are more than 12,700 photographs from wind farms and turbines. Statistics about wind energy in all countries where wind farms are installed, together with cartographic data, also included on the website.

Updated weekly, the site provides access to most of the data. For deeper research, it is possible to buy the databases.

The Wind Power offers a complete approach which is achieved by interlinking different information, giving the interested reader the option of seeing in one glimpse which project is planned and by whom and which turbines are being used and by whom they are being operated.

The aim of the database is to include all wind farms, developers , operators, owners, manufacturers and turbines so that regular updates arrive weekly.

The content is mostly free, but for a more in depth analysis it is possible to buy databases (for further information see Prices & Services on the website).

- Installed capacity figures, year by year, for more than 100 countries
- Hundreds of interactive maps
